EASTER THOUGHTS

New Church congregations around the world have diversity in imagery use to reflect faith. There are fewer images of the cross that you are used to seeing in other churches, because the New Church puts the emphasis on the Risen Lord, not on His suffering on the cross.

The New Church teaches that all people of all faiths will go to heaven if they believe in one God and live in charity and kindness according to the principles of their religion's persuasion. It is what is in your heart that determines your eternal condition, not what is in your mind only, or the words on your tongue, or the membership card in your wallet. When people arrive in the spiritual world after the death of the physical body, they are not asked, "What is your religion?" but rather, "What is your life?"
